RESOLVED, that the School Board of Independent School District 271 accepts a \$10,000 grant from the Greater Twin Cities United Way to purchase three MakerSpace 3D printers.

**BACKGROUND:**

Greater Twin Cities United Way (GTCUW) is providing funding in the amount of \$10,000 to purchase three MakerSpace 3D printers. Kennedy and Jefferson High Schools each wrote a grant for a printer to be placed in their media center. Bloomington Career and College Academy (BCCA) will use a MakerSpace 3D printer in a manufacturing classroom. BCCA was awarded the funds in order to purchase the printers for all three sites.
